

Special Meeting Minutes  
10-12-2022

Supervisor Runyan called meeting order at 2PM. Clerk Raffin, Treasurer Righi and Trustee Deska were in attendance, Trustee McDonald was absent. Also in attendance were Jamie Winkelman from the maintenance department, Jeff McDonald our Zoning Administrator, Ed Duke from Duke Construction out of Mio, Michigan and Heather Runyan Recording Secretary. The Purpose of the Special Meeting was to discuss the options and answer question about a possible Pavilion to be built in the Township Park.

Mr. Duke brought drawings from his previous build in Rose City that is already ADA approved. The drawing depicted a building 72ft x 36ft with 13ft of that being storage and spray down cleanable bathrooms. Mr. Duke suggested an exposed aggregate for the concrete, saying it looks nice, more traction and depending on wear and usage you shouldn't have to reseal it for at least 5 years. If we decided to not have bathroom, he suggested still plumbing the holes so that you were not coming back in ten years trying to drill through the concrete if you them wanted to add them.

Questions were raised about how the size would fit into the park, so we adjourn to the park with tape measure and cans and walked off the approximate location. During this time, it was discussed that we do not know exact locations of the drain fields, septic or the cistern. McDonald will get on that along with Miss Dig for electrical and gas lines.

No decisions were made at the meeting, it was just informative. Meeting Adjourned at 3:25 PM.
